



SATURDAY QUALIFYING PUTS DUCATI MOTOLOGIC RACING ON FRONT ROW

Two-time Australian Superbike Champion Jamie Stauffer takes a position on the front row for tomorrow's races with consistent improvement throughout both official practice days on Thursday and Friday placing him 4th on the grid for Race 1 at Hidden Valley Raceway in Darwin for Round 2 of the Australian Superbike Championship.

Having only sighted the track for the first time on Thursday for practice where many of the other major teams tested early last week, both the Ducati Motologic 1198R riders have demonstrated their professionalism and skill in being a quick study of the circuit.

With #27 Jamie Stauffer on the front row in 4th and Rookie #33 Jordan Burgess qualifying very well yet again at his second race event on a Superbike to place 15th on the grid, the Ducati Motologic Racing Team are confident of strong results in Sunday's racing.
